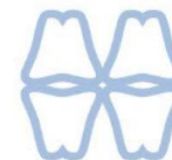

No Dental Insurance???

The West Kootenay Community TEETH Clinic Society believes all people deserve access to dental care. We endeavor to make dental care more affordable.

WK Community TEETH Clinic Society is a not-for-profit program offering high quality dental care, including a Mobile Dental Hygiene Clinic for West Kootenay Boundary low income community members, children, their families and seniors. Standard dentures are contracted at the Record Ridge Denture Clinic in Trail or Castlegar as funds are available.

All community members with a net family income of less than \$30,000 adjusted and 3 months of residency are eligible for dental services at the clinic.

The clinic accepts all government dental insurance plans, including: Healthy Kids, First Nations Health Benefits, Interim Federal Health Benefits, private dental plans, and people receiving Income Assistance.

The Clinic has received funding support from

Pacific Blue Cross Community Connection Foundation, Enterprising Non-Profit, Columbia Basin Trust, Henry Schein, BC Government and The WK Dental Hygiene Study Group.

The clinic offers qualified residents without dental insurance and an annual income of less than \$30,000 a reduction of approximately 40% off dental procedural costs found in the BC Dental Fee Guide. The Nelson clinic is able to offer a limited number of payment plans. Duration of payments can be spread over a maximum of 3 months interest free. Minimum payment of \$25 due at first appointment. Bill must be paid in full before the next treatment can be scheduled.

LATE FEES

(Many folks are waiting for their turn.)

There is a no show & late cancellation fee of \$20.00 if less than 48 hours notice is given that must be paid before another appointment will be booked.



West Kootenay Community TEETH Clinic Society is a non-profit society that relies on donations to pay for subsidized procedures. Donations will be gladly accepted with a charitable tax receipt issued for amounts over \$20.00 by Seniors Coordinating Society.
