Information Sheet

- incorporated 2003 as a non-profit organization by a group of concerned citizens to enhance and support local health care services;
- community-based volunteer board;
- purchased premises (old forestry building) May 2006, which is now known as the **Nelson and Area Wellness and Education Centre** and houses traditional and alternative medical personnel for a "one-stop" health centre;
- profits reinvested into health-care services.

Membership

- present membership is over 1,400;
- each member has one vote no matter how many shares they own;
- shares are \$10 each (individuals) with corporations needing 10 shares = \$100. Any amount of shares can be purchased and they are good for a lifetime.
- Membership forms are available from the lobby of the **Wellness and Education Centre**, 518 Lake Street, and can be slid under the door of the Health Co-op Office (main floor, through lobby, turn left, first door on left with CFHC sign) or mailed to the address above. Your membership card will be mailed to you.

Present Occupants and their Specialties

Community Health Resource Centre

- This is an area provided rent-free by the Partners of the **Wellness and Education Centre** for local health organizations. It provides a meeting place for all non-profit organizations upon their purchase of a \$100 Community First Health Co-op membership. The organizations involved are ALS, Alzheimer, Arthritis, Brain Injury, Cancer, Heart & Stroke, Friends of Family, Hospice, Kidney, Kidsport, Lung, MS Society, Nelson Elders, Parkinson's, Rise above Pain Society, Seniors Coordinating, and TOPS. CFHC is also the founding partner of the West Kootenay Community TEETH Clinic Society which offers low-cost dental services to area residents presently on a government program or with a family income of less than \$30,000.
